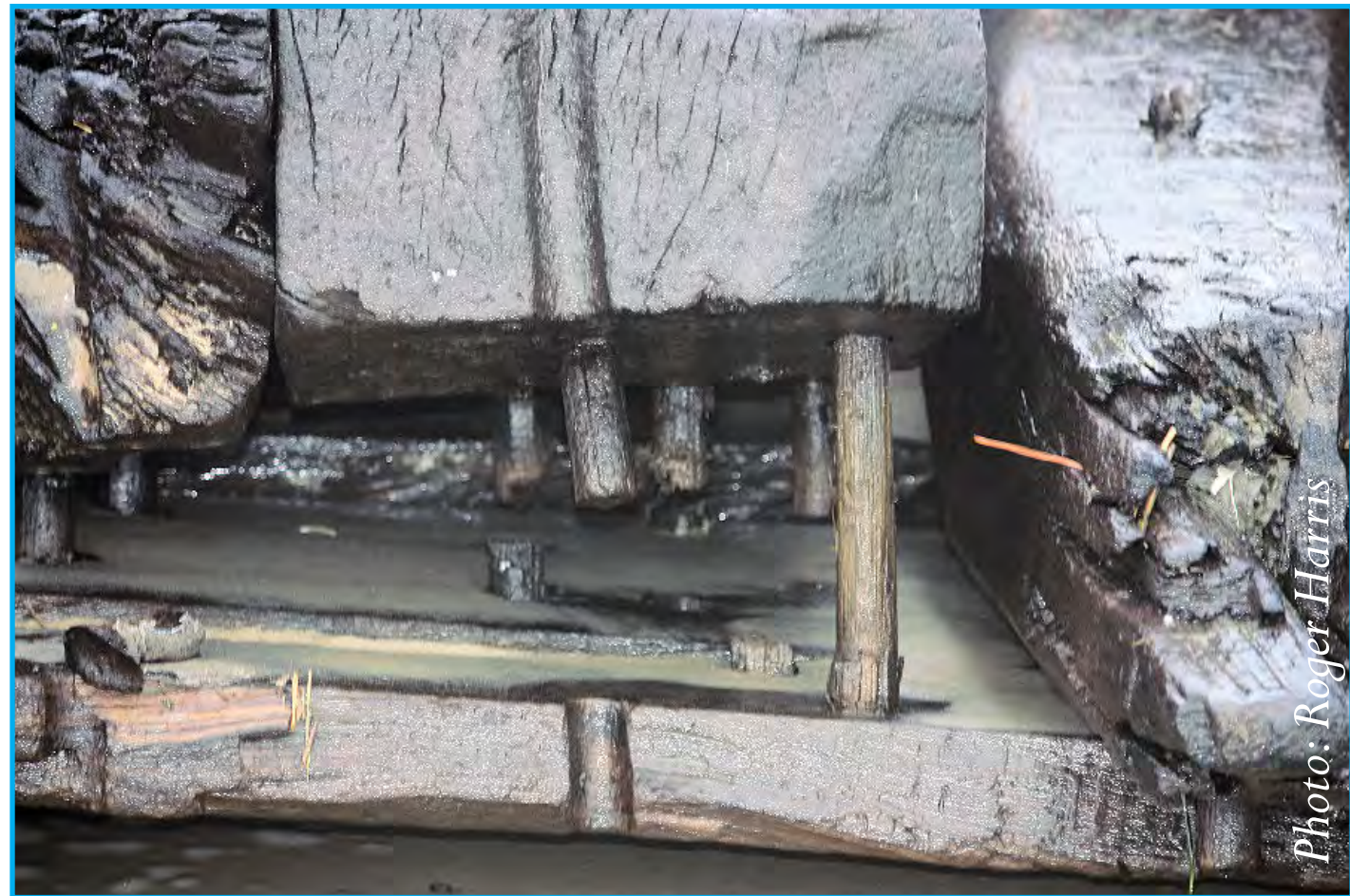

Forward floors



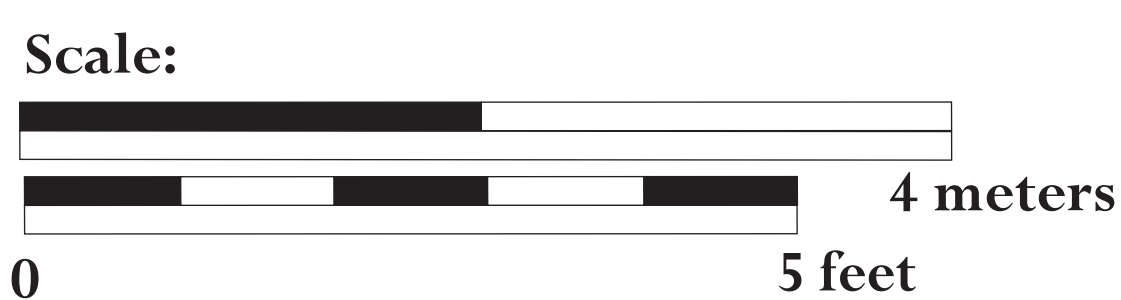
Port side floors and half frames



Detail of trunnels connecting half frames with outerhull planking

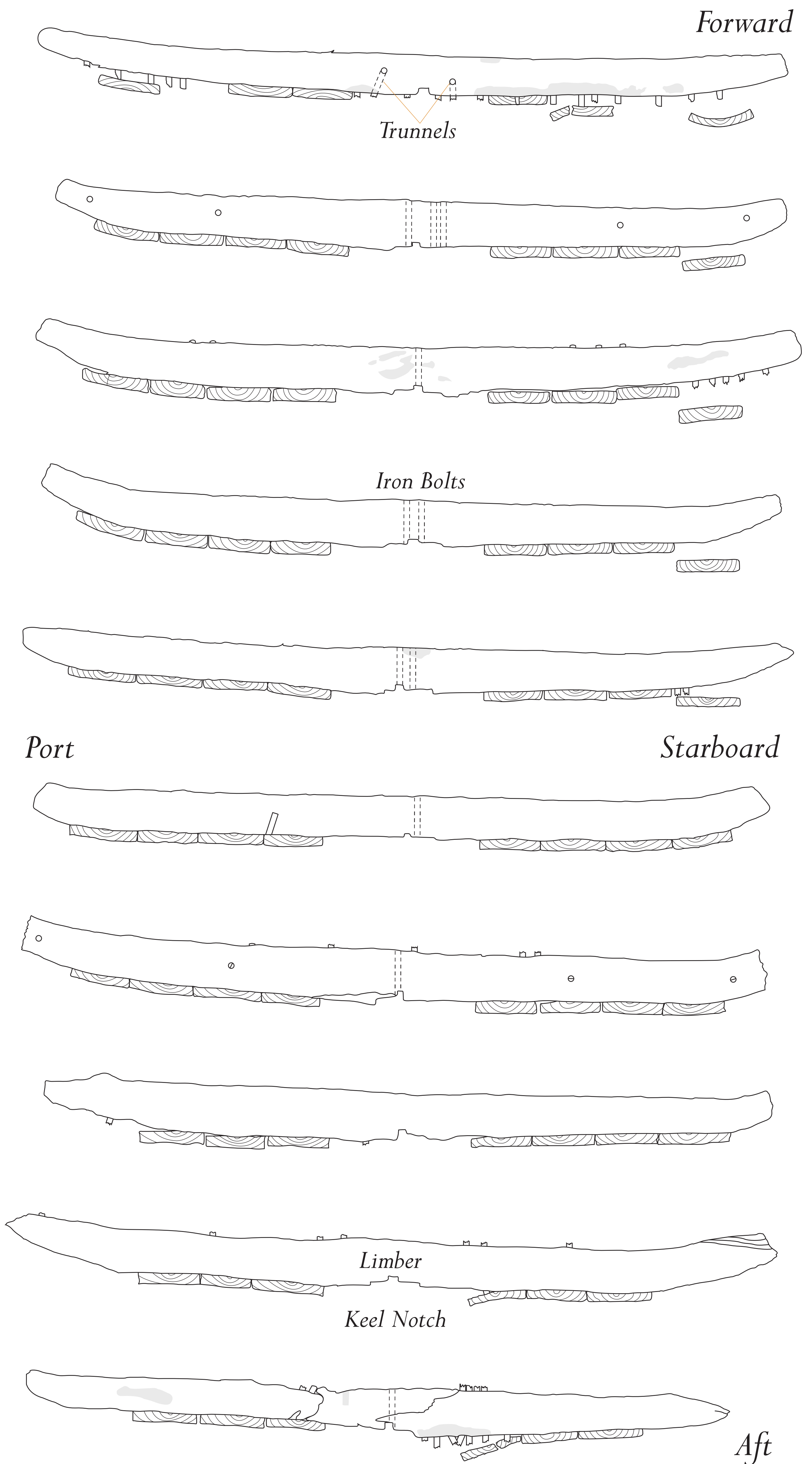


Starboard side floors and half frames
